Aicardi Syndrome a.k.a. Callosal Agenesis: Definition, Etiology, Molecular Pathogenesis, Prevalence and more. In 1965, a French neurologist, Dr Jean Dennis Aicardi, described 8 children with infantile spasm-in-flexion, total or partial agenesis of the corpus callosum, and variable ocular abnormalities. An additional 7 patients were described in 1969, and in 1972, Dennis and Bower established the Aicardi syndrome designation. These additional characteristics include: · Abnormal facies, · Cleft lip and palate, · Vertebral body abnormalities, and · Abnormalities of neuronal migration.
